

Oral Reading Fluency Skills Goal Setting

Fluent Readers:

- Read at an appropriate rate
- Make few pronunciation errors
- Sound like they are talking when they are reading
- Make a plan for figuring out unknown words
- Re-read to correct mistakes
- Do not stop frequently to ask for assistance

Reading Strategies

Taking my time and reading at a reasonable rate that helps me understand the text.	Stretching the sounds in unknown words.	Listening carefully to feedback and focusing on correcting my errors in the next reading.
